INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING REGISTRATION APPLICATION

Applicant Please Note: I certify that the information submitted on this document is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and I agree to abide by the rule set forth by the ASPC/AMHR/ASPR.. If there is ever a question about the age of this animal, you must agree to have said animal inspected and/or mouthed to verify its age. Remember – The information contained on this application will be used as documentation for the registration certificate. **BE SURE YOU ARE CORRECT** on the spelling of all names, registration numbers, the complete foaling date, and the accurate description of the animal

1. **FEE -- \$25.00 U.S. Dollars**
 2. **ELIGIBILITY – Any pony that is registered with the American Shetland Pony Club, the American Hackney Horse Society, or any pony that is the result of the mating of a registered Shetland and a registered Hackney pony is eligible for registration as an American Show Pony upon completion of an application for registration and submission of the appropriate fee.**
 - A. **To double register a Shetland Pony currently registered with the ASPC, the owner must complete the ASPR registration application and include a copy of the animal's ASPC registration certificate.**
 - B. **To double register a Hackney Pony currently registered with the AHHS, a photocopy of the animal's Hackney registration certificate (front and back, showing current owner of record) must accompany the completed registration application.**
 - C. **To register an animal that is the result of mating a registered Shetland with a registered Hackney pony, a photocopy of the Hackney registration certificate (front and back, showing current owner of record) must accompany the registration application.**
 3. **HEIGHT – All American Show Ponies must meet the dual height requirements as follows:**
 - A. **The maximum overall exhibition height must be 48 inches or less.**
 - B. **The measurement from the highest point of the withers to the hairline of the coronet band at the heel shall not exceed 46 inches; i.e. total overall measurement at the withers minus the total heel measurement including foot, pad, and shoe shall not exceed 46 inches.**
 4. **SIGNATURE OF OWNER – Owner, or owner's authorized agent must sign the application. Owner Signature Card must be on file with the ASPR office.**
 5. **FOALING DATE – Give month, day, and year. There shall be no age limit set for registration of a pony into the American Show Pony Registry.**
 6. **NAME OF ANIMAL – Two name choices are requested in case one name has already been taken. Names cannot have more than thirty-five (35) letters, including spaces and punctuation.**
 7. **SEX – Circle whether the pony is a STALLION, MARE, OR GELDING (include gelding date).**
 8. **NAME AND NUMBER OF SIRE AND DAM – Give COMPLETE name of sire and dam and the registration numbers.**
 9. **COLOR – Please be specific. "Dapple" or "Roan" alone cannot be accepted as color. Appaloosa is not acceptable.**
 10. **Submit 4 current photographs of the animal (1) Full profile/side view of left side; (2) Full profile/side view of right side; In either right or left side photo the horse's head must be turned towards the camera with the forelock pulled back to show face markings or lack of. (3) Full facing forward frontal view; and (4) Full rear view. All four legs must be seen from both sides; markings on face must be visible. All photos should include all parts of the animal available in that view (ears to hooves or nose to tail inclusive) and be unobstructed by any other object or animal. Photos must be a minimum of 3" X 5" and a maximum of 4 X 6". Scanned, digital or computer generated photos, if they are received on photographic paper, are acceptable. Additional photos should be submitted to verify markings not seen in the standard four photos (i.e., white on belly, markings under mane area, etc). Label each photo with first choice of name and owner's name on the back. All Photos will be kept on file.**
 11. **BREEDER – Owner of the dam at the time of service.**

PHOTO REQUIREMENTS

ALL PHOTOS SHOULD HAVE THE HORSE'S NAME AND/OR REGISTRATION NUMBER ON BACK.

Photos should meet the following criteria:

IF ANY PART OF HORSE IS CUT OFF WE WILL RETURN THE PHOTOS

EXAMPLE: HEAD, EARS, HOOVES STANDING IN GRASS.

WE MUST BE ABLE TO SEE THE HORSE FROM HEAD TO HOOF

Photos should be no smaller than 3" X 5" and no larger than 4" X 6"; digital photos will be accepted if printed on photo quality paper. At this time, photos may not be emailed due to resolution creating scanning errors. If your horse has markings that are not visible in the required photos and you wish to have these markings on file (i.e. belly splash), you may include additional photos of such markings. All photos will be kept on file. Front & Rear view may have reversed photos sizes (i.e. 5"x 3"; 6"x 4") and be vertical instead of horizontal. **Polaroid photos are not accepted because of size and scan quality.**

Left Side – full standing left profile from ears to hooves and nose to tail; in either right or left side photos, animal's head should be turned toward photographer to show full face and forelock should be off to one side so that face markings are not obscured; legs should be positioned so that the inside of the right side legs show – not placed together as they might be in setting up to show in the ring; animal should be standing on a surface that allows full view of hooves; head should not be turned away from photographer; the majority of the photo should be of the animal being registered. The animal may have a halter on and should be groomed/clean so that color and markings show correctly.

Right Side – full standing right profile from ears to hooves and nose to tail; in either right or left side photos, animal's head should be turned toward photographer to show full face and forelock should be off to one side so that face markings are not obscured; legs should be positioned so that the inside of the right side legs show – not placed together as they might be in setting up to show in the ring; animal should be standing on a surface that allows full view of hooves; head should not be turned away from photographer; the majority of the photo should be of the animal being registered. The animal may have a halter on and should be groomed/clean so that color and markings show correctly.

Front View – Animal should be facing photographer squarely; full front view must include front legs; forelock should be off to one side so that face markings are not obscured; the majority of the photo should be of the animal being registered. The animal may have a halter on and should be groomed/clean so that color and markings show correctly.

Rear View – Photographer should be squarely behind the animal; full rear view must include rear legs, tail should be straight down; however, if tail is hiding markings, it may be pulled to one side; the majority of the photo should be of the animal being registered. The animal may have a halter on and should be groomed/clean so that color and markings show correctly.

Once the animal has received the new photo certificate, new photos may be sent with future registry work, however, new photos are NOT required for future registry work unless there are color/markings changes, or the owner desires a photo update. When a customer requests a photo update only, there will be a \$20.00 certificate change fee.
